This is the general weekly cycle that starts of with Sunday of every week upon ever solar month in the Julian / Gregorian calendar. **Note: This Roman weekly cycle is no where found or mentioned in scripture, nor is it identical with the Hebraic weekly cycle.**

Sunday	1	Dies Solis (day of the Sun)
Monday	2	Dies Lunae (day of the moon)
Tuesday	3	Dies Martis (day of Mars)
Wednesday	4	Dies Mercuri (day of Mercury)
Thursday	5	Dies Iovis (day of Jupiter)
Friday	6	Dies Veneris (day of Venus)
Saturday	7	Dies Saturni (day of Saturn)
